Bowhunter Safety Course



The MCLB Albany Game Warden is providing a bowhunter's safety course that is mandatory for all bowhunters aboard MCLB Albany. This course will satisfy the annual safety briefing and archery qualification, and is free to all MCLB Albany bowhunters. The course provides eight hours of training and is offered in two phases:



Phase 1

Phase 1 is a four hour online training course that must be completed prior to registering for Phase 2. Bowhunters can register for Phase 1 by visiting <http://www.bowhunter-ed.com/>, and clicking on the "Florida" icon. You can then complete the free account registration and begin the course. There is a test at the end of the course with approximately 50 questions. When you have achieved a passing score, print the screen showing the score and stop there. Do not sign up for the Field Day online. The online course covers:



- Wildlife Conservation
- Safe & Responsible Bowhunting
- Know Your Bow and Arrow
- Preparation Before the Hunt
- Methods of Bowhunting
- Shot Placement & Recovery Techniques
- Outdoor Preparedness



Phase 2

Upon successful completion of Phase 1, MCLB Albany bowhunters will register for the four hour Phase 2 Field Day course by contacting the Game Warden at 639-5188/6261. The course will begin at Bldg 5500, I&E Conference Room for the administrative portion and move to the Game Warden building for the practical application. Bring a copy of your online score to the Field Day. Phase 2 will serve as a review of the Phase 1 course listed above as well as the items listed below:



- Proper Safe Climbing Techniques
- Proper Harness Use
- Fall Recovery Techniques
- Target Acquisition
- Bow Qualification
