2013 Safety Perception Survey Results


MCLB Albany Command employees participated in a third National Safety Council's (NSC) Safety Barometer Survey. The overall score is a high

100%

Compared to 85% in 2010 and 94% in 2011

This indicates that the 480 organizations in the NSC Database received a lower average response score than MCLB Albany.

This table shows the current 2013 Safety Barometer Survey results compared to the 2010 and 2011 Safety Barometer Survey results for Marine Corps Logistics Base Albany.



Comparing 2013 Safety Barometer Survey results to previous years:

- All six program categories showed increases
- Five of the six program categories received a 100 percentile score
- MCLB Albany increased 6% from 2011 and 15% from 2010 in the overall categories
- Supervisory group reported the most positive safety program perception for all six program categories
- Employee knowledge of the Commander setting annual safety goals increased 51% from 2011 and 39% from 2010
- Safety training in new employee orientation increased 60% from 2011 and 44% from 2010
- Twelve performing components received the highest possible percentile score of 100
- Forty-nine of the 50 performing components increased in percentile scores from 2011
- Forty-seven of the 50 components received very high scores at or above 90%
- Eleven performing components showed substantial improvement of 20 points

ANALYSIS

Bottom Line: MCLB Albany Command has a "world class" safety program indicating outstanding performance that exceeds nearly all of the organizations in the NSC Database.
