

DRIVE SOBER OR GET PULLED OVER

The Labor Day weekend is one of the most dangerous times of the year to be on the road in terms of drunk-driving fatalities. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) reported during the 2016 Labor Day holiday:

- 43% of nationwide crash fatalities involved drunk drivers.
- 54% were drivers under 21 years old.
- 60% of the drivers had a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of +0.15%.

The legal limit for driving under the influence (DUI) is 0.08%.





Here are a few tips to help you have a safer Labor Day:

- Before drinking, choose a non-drinking friend as a designated driver.
- If you are hosting the party, make sure all guests leave with a sober driver.
- If you see a drunk driver on the road, call law enforcement immediately.
- Always wear your seat belt. It is the best defense against drunk drivers.
- Use NHTSA's SaferRide app to call a taxi or a friend. This app will help keep drunk drivers off the roads by allowing users to identify their location and call a taxi or friend to pick them up.
