1. Situation

a. Marine Corps Logistics Base (MCLB) Albany will establish an installation shooting team in order to support the intent of reference (a) and the Competition in Arms Program (CIAP).

b. The ultimate goal of Marine Corps marksmanship training is to increase the combat effectiveness of the individual Marine. The fundamental skills learned at entry and sustainment levels are applied in competition style shooting. The MCLB Albany Shooting Team (MCLBAST) serves as a mechanism for identifying Marines who may compete in the Eastern Division Matches (EDM), the first level of competition in the CIAP. Additionally, the MCLBAST may also compete at the Service, inter-service, local and national levels per reference (a).

2. Mission. To establish a standing team of highly trained marksmen to represent MCLB Albany and its tenant commands in competitive shooting sports, stress the development and application of the fundamentals of marksmanship, promote the exchange of ideas, and further the advancement of marksmanship knowledge in order to increase combat effectiveness and efficiency.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent. To motivate and provide an incentive to develop and maintain a population of Marines with refined skills in rifle and pistol marksmanship. Marines will receive detailed instructions in fundamentals, coaching techniques, and mind set.

b. Concept of Operations. The MCLBAST will conduct monthly training in conjunction with regularly scheduled pistol ranges aboard MCLB Albany. Once the announcement of EDM or other competition dates have been published, the training schedules will be adjusted to ensure the MCLBAST is prepared. Team training will follow an ebb and flow cycle around approved competitions. Training schedules will be published for each approved competition.

c. Tasks

(1) Executive Officer. Appoint a Shooting Team Captain in writing.

(2) Director, Operations & Training Division

(a) Provide range quotas as necessary to support the training schedule of the MCLBAST.

(b) Ensure sufficient ammunition allotment is available to support the MCLBAST annual training schedule.

(3) Director, Logistics Support Division. Ensure a Limited Technical Inspection (LTI) and Pre-Fire Inspection (PFI) is performed on all MCLBAST weapons selected for use for authorized competitions.

(4) Commanding General, Marine Corps Logistics Command. Request the widest dissemination and opportunity for participation on the MCLBAST. All military personnel are encouraged to participate and civilians may participate on a space-available basis.

(5) Officer-in-Charge (OIC), Marine Corps Systems Command. Request the widest dissemination and opportunity for participation on the MCLBAST. All military personnel are encouraged to participate and civilians may participate on a space-available basis.

(6) Team Captain

(a) Serve as the OIC for the MCLBAST; ensure appropriate coordination with Base Operations and Armory for all training events. Be cognizant that the team serves as representative of the Base Commander and ensure proper conduct.

(b) Coordinate directly with Base Operations and Armory for support/de-confliction of all training evolutions.

(c) Ensure MCLBAST training is conducted in accordance with the references.

(d) Submit Operational Risk Management (ORM) worksheets to Executive Officer, MCLB Albany no later than seven days prior to conducting any off base training evolutions.

(e) Ensure appropriate documentation and security is provided when transporting weapons off the installation in accordance with references.

(f) Establish and maintain inventory and control of all shooting team equipment.

d. Coordinating Instructions. Uniform for the Shooting team will be the seasonal MarPat uniform. The team will maintain uniformity during all competitions. Variations to the MarPat uniform (shooting jackets and sweatshirts) are authorized while on the ranges only.

4. Administration and Logistics

a. ORM will be utilized throughout all training evolutions.

b. MCLBAST members are authorized to transport personal weapons aboard the installation provided they are transporting them in support of scheduled training evolutions and they are stored/transported in accordance with reference (e).

5. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to Headquarters Battalion and all tenant commands aboard MCLB Albany.

b. Signal. This Order is effective the date signed.
