who have a complaint of non-criminal nature should use the Informal Resolution System as a means to resolve the situation. For those incidents that are more serious, any of the avenues outlined in the Marine Corps Equal Opportunity Manual (MCO P5354.1D) or the Request Mast Process should be used.

Discrimination—to include sexual harassment, reprisal, or any other conduct that demeans the dignity of another person—will not be tolerated.

In all cases, we will strive to solve the issue at the lowest possible level. If you have any questions, please pass them through your chain of command via your immediate supervisor.
