Our shipments from DoD's flu vaccine supplier are delayed. Currently, we anticipate availability of flu vaccine:

- Operational Forces October
- Other Active Duty late November
- All Other Patients December

You have options to get a flu shot:

- Active Duty*, Families** & Retirees can get a flu shot at a TRICARE network pharmacy.
 - There's no cost, if administered by a pharmacist.
 - If a provider at an on-site clinic administers the vaccine, it might not be covered.
