

**MARINE CORPS LOGISTICS BASE ALBANY
FIREARM REGULATIONS ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM**

I _____, acknowledge that I have read and understand BO 5530.2A (Privately Owned Weapons, Ammunition and Explosives). Specially, I understand the following:

1. All individuals residing aboard MCLB Albany must register all privately owned firearms with the Marine Corps Police Department (Pass and Identification Office, Building 3010) within 10 working days of initially bringing the weapon(s) on base. Firearms must be store in a gun safe or strongbox capable of being locked with a key or combination lock. Ammunition must be secured separately from firearms an in a container capable of being locked with a key or combination lock.
2. Under no circumstances will any firearm or ammunition be accessible children, without close parental supervision.
3. All firearms will remain unloaded until I am actually participating in authorized recreational shooting or hunting.
4. When transporting privately owned firearms and ammunition aboard the base, the firearm must be equipped with a trigger lock or cable lock and secured in a locked case/compartment.
5. Under no circumstances will firearms, weapons, or ammunition be permanently stored in a privately owned vehicle aboard the Base.
6. Carrying a concealed weapon is prohibited aboard the base.
7. Violation of this Order by military personnel is punishable as violation of Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) and can subject the violator to court martial or other judicial or administrative action. Individuals not subject to the UCMJ who fail to comply are subject to adverse administrative action or criminal prosecution as authorized by references U.S. Navy Regulation 1159 18 U.S.C. 921-929. Violations by other individuals may subject the violator to trial in the Federal courts for violation of 18 U.S.C 921-929.
