7 STANDARDS TO FOLLOW WHEN DRIVING A FORKLIFT

In the U.S. from 2021 to 2022, there were over 73 work related fatalities and over 24,000 incidents related to forklifts, Material Handling Equipment and Power Industrial Trucks, per the Bureau of Labor Statistics. To prevent more incidents this year, some standards are:

Don't carry loads at dangerous heights while on the move







Be careful going down steep inclines with unusual loads





Driving too fast can be dangerous for pedestrians and bystanders





Follow correct parking procedures to prevent a runaway lift truck







Take care in loading areas to prevent your lift truck falling









Don't carry passengers
- a lift truck is not a bus!







Keep your arms and legs in the lift truck



Never transport anyone other than you and your load
