According to OSHA, sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) accounts for 13% of all workplace fatalities and is the leading cause of death in the U.S. However, prompt CPR, followed by a shock from an AED within three minutes can increase the chance of survival to 70%. That's why making CPR and AED training part of your emergency-response plan is so important.

MCLB Albany's Fire and Emergency Services provides multiple courses that empower the workforce to increase the survivability of victims of an emergency. These courses include Stop-the-Bleed, CPR, and AED Training.
